Affordable Care Act (Obamacare)



Now that the Affordable Care Act (ACA) is the law of the land we have to file a couple of new forms with the taxes this year. Some of you will receive form 1095A and some will not. Please look for this form in the mail, if you don't receive it, don't worry, you probably had a different insurance.

1099 Forms

Please pay attention to each 1099 that you receive, any mail that says "**Important Tax Information**" on it. Make sure you have all of them when we get together. Paying attention and making sure that we report it will save you from an IRS letter(a nastygram) later in the year.

Health Savings Accounts (HSAs)

Contributions to a Health Savings Account (HSA) are used to pay current or future medical expenses of the account owner, his or her spouse, and any qualified dependent. Medical expenses must not be reimbursable by insurance or other sources and do not qualify for the medical expense deduction on a federal income tax return.

A qualified individual must be covered by a High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) and not be covered by other health insurance with the exception of insurance for accidents, disability, dental care, vision care, or long-term care.

For calendar year 2015, a qualifying HDHP must have a deductible of at least \$1,250 for self-only coverage or \$2,500 for family coverage (unchanged from 2014) and must limit annual out-of-pocket expenses of the beneficiary to \$6,350 for self-only coverage (up \$100 from 2014) and \$12,700 for family coverage (up \$200 from 2014).
